



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Education Department, New Taipei City Government, Taiwan (R.O.C.)

and

Chihlee University of Technology, Taiwan (R.O.C.)

and

Cerritos College, U.S.A.

The three institutions shall be referred to collectively as the “Participating Institutions” in the MOU.

Endeavoring to increase cooperation in education, the Participating Institutions, after approval by their responsible authorities, agree to conclude this Memorandum on educational cooperation. The Participating Institutions shall promote collaboration and attempt to pursue the development of language education and training programs and culture exchange. To carry out the programs, detailed agreements shall be made between the Participating Institutions upon further discussions.

This MOU shall be determined through a joint discussion of the Participating Institutions and shall have a duration of five years, after which any extension or amendments may be made as agreed by the Participating Institutions. Either Institution may terminate or renew this MOU by giving three months’ written notice to the other Institutions and under mutual agreement.

This MOU is not intended to be a legally binding document. It is meant to describe the nature of and suggest the guidelines of such collaboration. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of collaboration institutions, nor will any constraints be imposed by either party upon the other in carrying out this MOU.

This Memorandum shall be signed in English in three duplicate originals. Each Institution should hold one original, each of which shall have the same legal effect.
